Should you wish to volunteer on a regular basis, please be aware that the Tasmanian Catholic Education Office requires all volunteers to hold a **current** **Working with Vulnerable People registration (WWVP)**.

Registration has a fee of \$19.44 and is completed online at <https://www.cbos.tas.gov.au/topics/licensing-and-registration/registrations/work-with-vulnerable-people/applications/apply>

You may visit up to 5 times at any Tasmanian Catholic College without a WWVP card, however you must always be accompanied by a person with a current WWVP registration.

The College is required to hold a copy of your registration card on file, and you are required to carry your card with you when volunteering. Your registration will be checked online at the time of you signing in at the office.
